

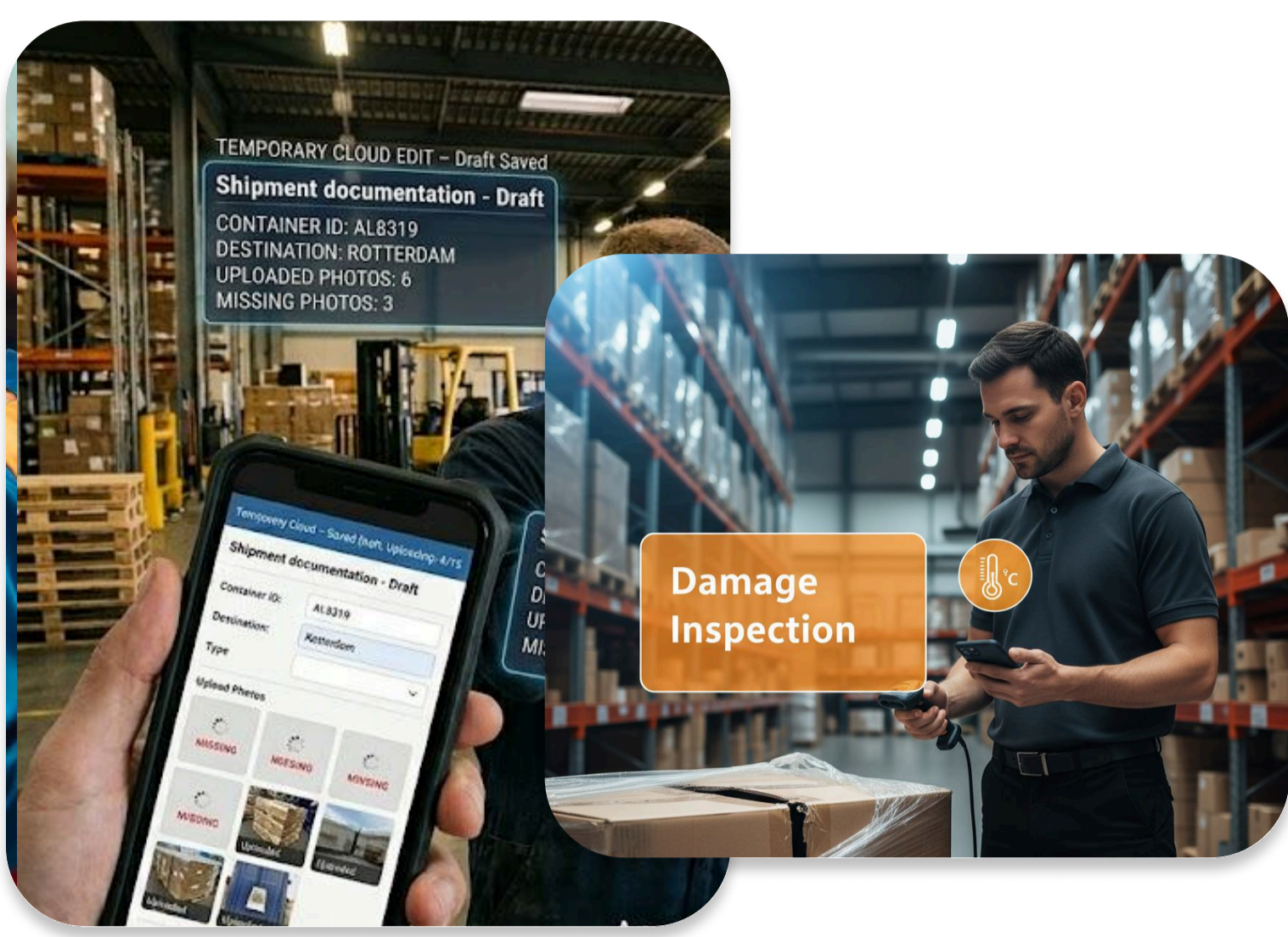

Incomplete Shipment Documentation: Save, Hand Off, and Complete Proof Across Every Shift

A loader captures the first set of photos. Shift change hits. The documentation is half done and the load ships in thirty minutes. Without a way to save incomplete shipment documentation, the next shift starts from scratch, or the load leaves with missing photos and the record is forever incomplete. Temporary Cloud fixes this. LoadProof lets you save incomplete shipment documentation to a secure cloud workspace, where any authorized user on any shift can open it, add missing photos, update metadata, and upload a completed record.

How Multi User Load Documentation Works



1. Shift Handoff Documentation

One employee can begin documenting a load while another authorized team member completes and uploads it later. This turns a hard stop into a pause. The next person opens the same record, sees exactly what has been captured, and continues without guessing what is missing. Incomplete shipment documentation stops being a problem and becomes a status, waiting for the next authorized user.



2. Cloud Edit Proof Documentation

Requirements change before a load is finalized. A supervisor asks for additional angle shots. A customer requests specific pallet documentation. Cloud edit documentation lets authorized users capture more images and attach them to pending shipment records before the final upload.



3. Complete Shipment Records Later

Modify shipment details, categories, and metadata to ensure records remain accurate and complete. Every field can be reviewed, corrected, and finalized before the record becomes permanent. Incomplete shipment documentation stays incomplete only as long as it needs to.



4. Warehouse Collaboration With Full Accountability

User permissions control who can view, edit, upload, or delete temporary cloud loads. Every action remains traceable, who captured, who edited, who uploaded. Warehouse documentation collaboration means multiple people contribute to a single record without losing visibility or control over who did what.



5. Flexible Upload Options

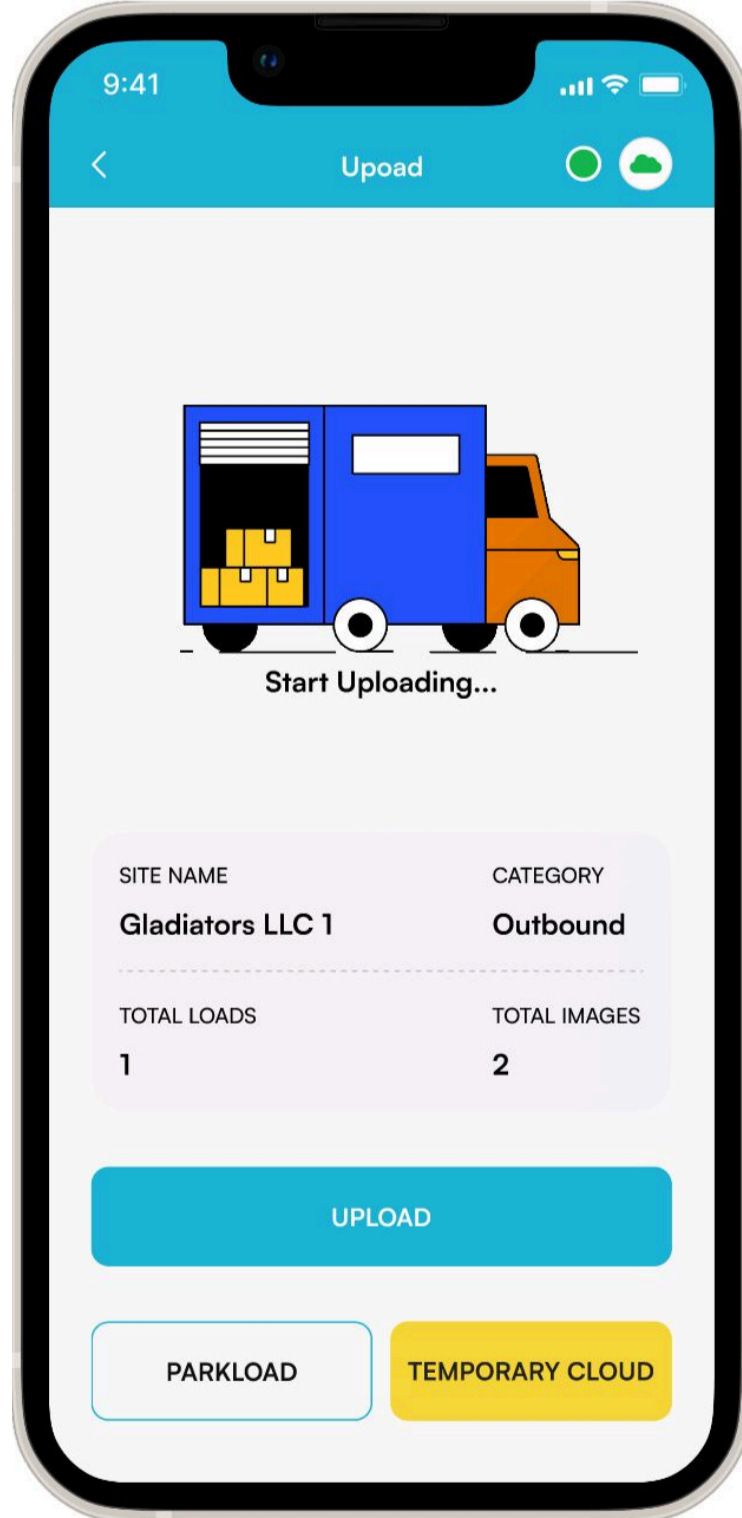
